### **About the GaDangme Council (GDC)**

The GaDangme Council (GDC) serves as the unifying body for GaDangme communities worldwide, bringing together traditional leadership, associations, and citizens under one coordinated framework. Its core mandate is to protect GaDangme identity, strengthen community cohesion, and advocate for cultural, social, and economic advancement.

Through structured engagement and sustainable planning, the Council promotes our language, heritage, customs, and collective values. The GDC further works to empower GaDangme people at home and in the diaspora through collaborative initiatives, capacity-building efforts, and representation at national and international levels.

#### Selected Achievements and Community Impact

The GDC has organised cultural festivals, educational forums, development conferences, and global stakeholder engagements that highlight GaDangme heritage while addressing contemporary issues. These programmes have helped expand awareness, build unity, and strengthen networks across generations and regions.

In addition, the Council has supported youth leadership initiatives, women's empowerment, educational access, community advocacy efforts, and diaspora mobilisation. The GDC continues to provide strategic direction and trusted leadership for development partners who seek meaningful collaboration with GaDangme communities.

#### Additional Milestones

The GaDangme Council was established in 1999 and fully incorporated in 2000. In 2022, a complete Executive Council was constituted, combining elected officers and Committee Chairpersons.

The new Executive activated all 13 committees - Legal, Women's Affairs, Lands, Heritage, Education, Health, Investments and others - after years of limited activity.

The Council now operates Cedi, Dollar, and Education Fund bank accounts after previously having none.

A comprehensive five-year Strategic Blueprint was developed to guide all activities and long-term planning.

The GDC, with strong support from the Ga Traditional Council, successfully opposed the government's proposed Kayayei Hostel project at Agbogbloshie, resulting in its cancellation.

Three Community FM radio frequencies have been secured to broadcast in the Ga and Dangme languages.

The Council sponsored a public demonstration to protest discrimination against GaDangme people.

To address the shortage of GaDangme language teachers, scholarships are provided for Ga and Dangme students at the Accra College of Education.

To support students access higher education, the University of Professional Studies Accra, offers full scholarships for various programs. Below is the summary of scholarships awarded over the years:

- 1. 2021/22: SIX
- 2. 2022/23: Two
- 3. 2023/24: Ten
- 4. 2024/25: Eleven
- 5. 2025/26: Eighteen
